<<Pause, drop repeaters, and listen>>

<<Wednesday, 7:30 p.m.>>

Good evening. This is the Greater San Lorenzo Valley ARES net. We meet here at 7:30 pm each Wednesday, except for the 3rd Wednesday and holidays. The 3rd Wednesday of the month is when the SLV ARES meeting happens at Cal Fire in Felton.

This net is one of many ways we maintain and improve our EMERGENCY preparedness.

ARES members, guests, and visitors are welcome on all of our ARES nets. We invite ALL amateurs to participate.

This is a DIRECTED net, so please do not transmit until indicated by Net Control. Those with emergency or priority traffic can interrupt at any time by saying break twice. Is there any emergency traffic now? This is _____(Name), _____(Callsign,Phonetically), Net Control.

<< Drop repeater, pause, listen >>

We'll begin the net with check-ins. Please pause between transmissions to allow the repeater to drop. When your callsign-suffix group is called, please check-in using standard phonetics, speaking slowly and clearly. First off, Stations with callsign-suffixes beginning with:

A – F Alpha thru Foxtrot please check-in now.

G – M Golf through Mike please check in now.

N – T November through Tango please check in now

U – Z Uniform through Zulu please check-in now.

Is there anyone anywhere in the alphabet that would like to check in now?

<< Move on when there are no more responses >>

Now we'll take Reports or Announcements. If you have a Report or Announcement, please give us your callsign PHONETICALLY now.

<< Pause. Acknowledge all callsigns first. Then allow reports if there are any. >>

<< If you have no training for the net >>

Is there Training for this evening's net?

<< Pause. If no reply, then just move along. >>

Is there any one else to check-in or anything else for the good of this net before we close it?

<< Long pause; Wait. Handle any reply, then repeat question before closing. Be patient. >>
